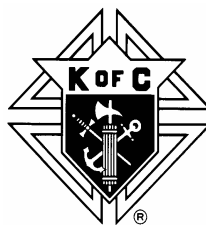

Greetings Brother Knights,

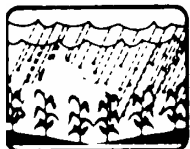

May God bless you and your families.

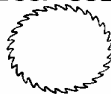
